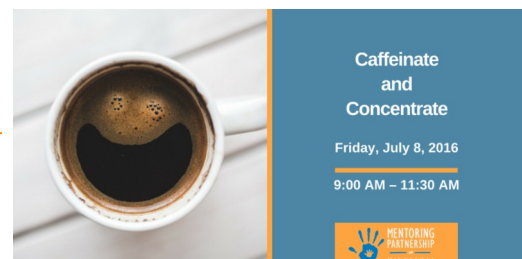

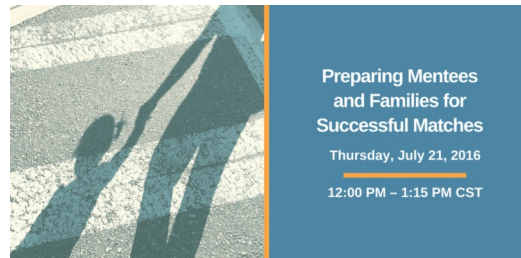

Initial mentee trainings can also be used to create a sense of camaraderie, and to inspire mentees to follow through with their commitments.

TAKE ACTION! BE A MENTORING ADVOCATE!

The U.S. House and Senate funding committees recently took action on the bills that fund the **Youth Mentoring grant** that's managed by the **Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP)** at the Department of Justice. Unfortunately, their respective bills provide very different funding recommendations, one of which would **cut the program by at least \$15 million**.



Tell Congress to help close the mentoring gap: Support a minimum of \$90M for CJS youth mentoring grant in FY17.

Currently, the OJJDP youth mentoring grant is funded at \$90 million. Despite **MENTOR: The National Mentoring Partnership (MENTOR)** and 39 national mentoring organizations encouraging Congress to increase funding for the grant in fiscal year 2017 (FY17), the Senate recommended only \$75 million and the House recommended level-funding of \$90 million in their bills. **MENTOR needs your help to ensure that a minimum of \$90 million is approved in the final FY17 funding bill.**
